Jenny Ray was born and educated in the United Kingdom.

From 1969 to 1980, she worked as assistant to the Deputy Executive Director of the International Coffee Organization, where she developed her interest and skills in conferences by assisting in the reporting of the Coffee Council.

From 1981, she has worked at the International Mobile Satellite Organization, starting in the Conference Section of Inmarsat and becoming Head of that Department in 1990. She was responsible for organizing all of Inmarsat's conferences at all levels - the Assembly of Parties, the Council, Committee and Working Groups, as well as the informal strategic meetings which became a feature of Inmarsat's decision making process. She was instrumental in the privatization process which culminated in 1999 in the maintenance of the international organization (IMSO) and the establishment of the private Company Inmarsat Ltd.

In April 1999, she became Head of Administration of IMSO, under Mr Jerzy Vonau, the first Director of the small Directorate. Her responsibilities cover a wide range of activities, including organization and reporting of meetings of the IMSO Assembly and Advisory Committee and management of the provision of all secretarial, financial, accounting and administrative services.
